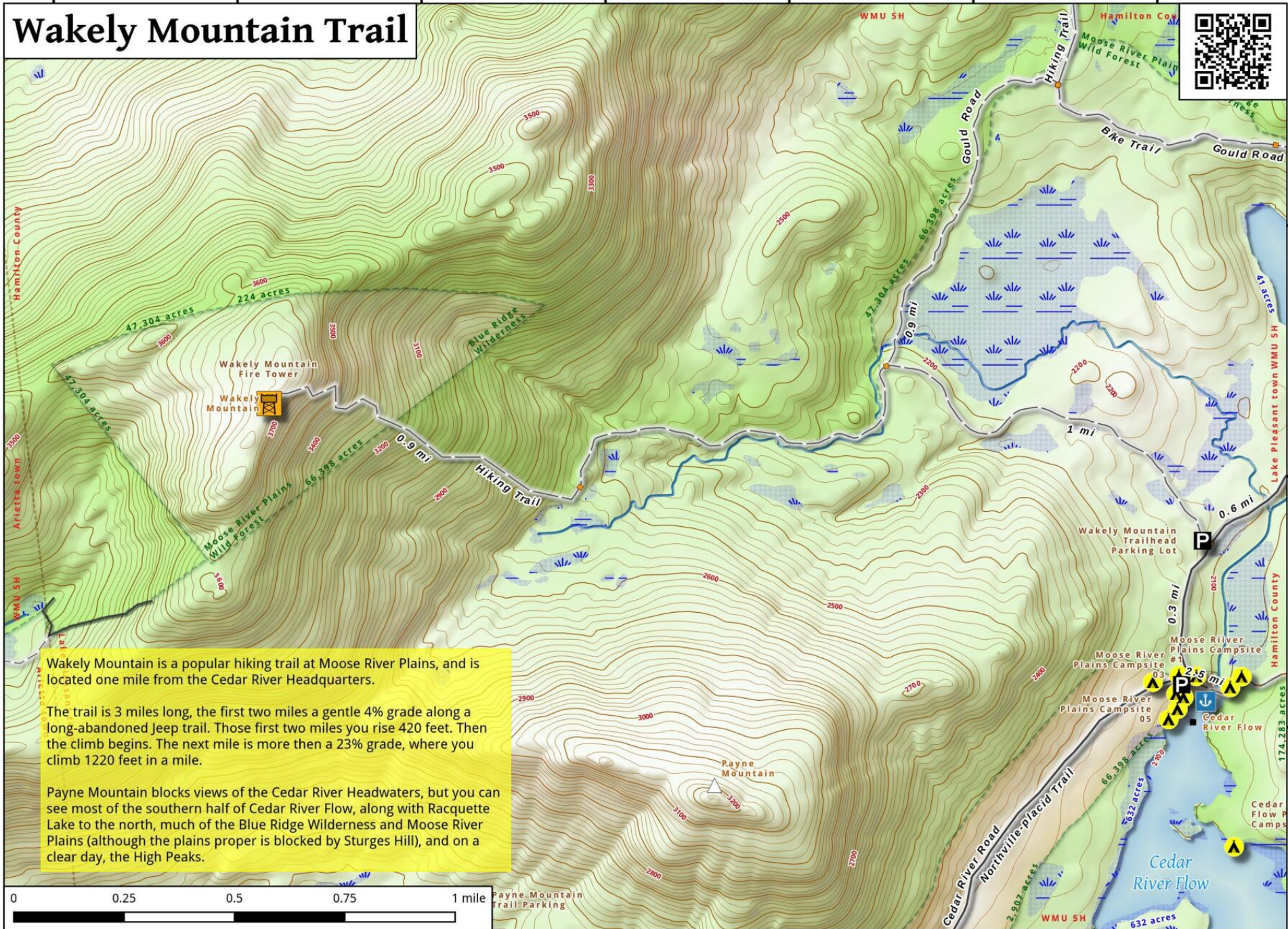

Wakely Mountain Trail



Wakely Mountain is a popular hiking trail at Moose River Plains, and is located one mile from the Cedar River Headquarters.

The trail is 3 miles long, the first two miles a gentle 4% grade along a long-abandoned Jeep trail. Those first two miles you rise 420 feet. Then the climb begins. The next mile is more than a 23% grade, where you climb 1220 feet in a mile.

Payne Mountain blocks views of the Cedar River Headwaters, but you can see most of the southern half of Cedar River Flow, along with Racquette Lake to the north, much of the Blue Ridge Wilderness and Moose River Plains (although the plains proper is blocked by Sturges Hill), and on a clear day, the High Peaks.
