



Rensselaerville State Forest is 2,310 acres in the Towns of Rensselaerville and Broome near the county line, about five miles east of the hamlet of Rensselaerville. Recently logged, there are several new campsites designated along roads, and haul roads which are nice for a stroll in the woods, mountain biking, skiing or snowmobiling in the winter. The forest itself is entirely within WMU 4H.
