



Rock City State Forest is located directly to the south of McCarthy Hill State Forest outside of Salamanca, north of Allegheny State Park. It is best known for "Little Rock City", a series of large square boulders that are the size of one to two story buildings with spaces between them that look like city streets. Near Little Rock City there are several pavilions with tables that are designated for tent camping. Another area designated for camping, is a large field with pavilions known as CCC Camp Seneca.
