

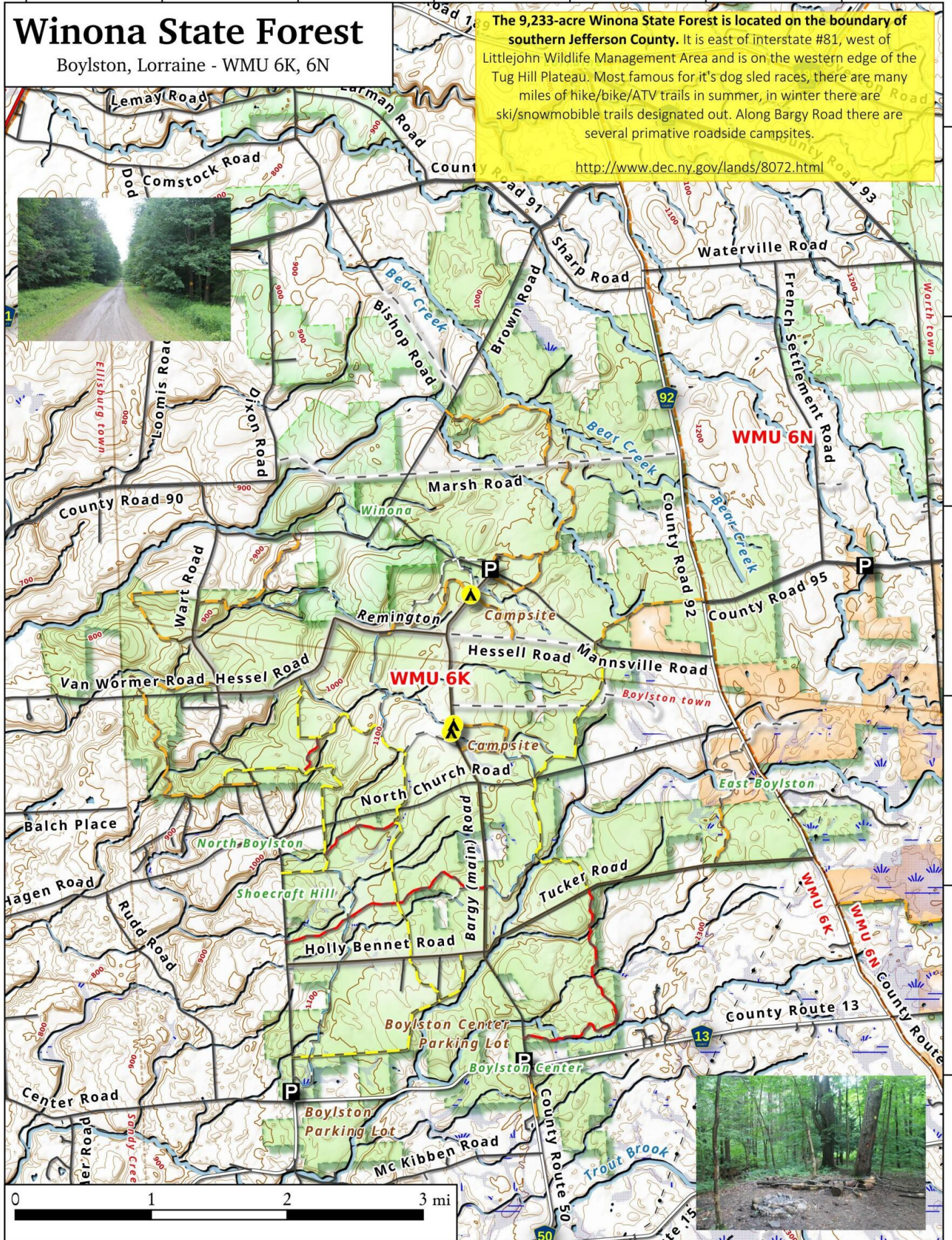

Winona State Forest

The 9,233-acre Winona State Forest is located on the boundary of southern Jefferson County. It is east of interstate #81, west of Littlejohn Wildlife Management Area and is on the western edge of the Tug Hill Plateau. Most famous for it's dog sled races, there are many miles of hike/bike/ATV trails in summer, in winter there are ski/snowmobile trails designated out. Along Bargy Road there are several primitive roadside campsites.
