

## **THERE ARE THREE OPTIONS TO CAST A VOTE FOR THE 2020 GENERAL ELECTION:**

- 1) Vote an absentee ballot.
- 2) Vote during the early voting period from Sat. Oct. 24 to Sun. Nov. 1st.
- 3) Vote on Election Day, Tuesday, Nov. 3 at your assigned polling place.

### **1) REQUEST AN ABSENTEE BALLOT**

- By going in-person or mailing a paper application to the Albany County Board of Elections, 260 S. Pearl St, Albany, NY 12202

You must apply online, postmark, email or fax a completed application or letter request for the General Election Absentee ballot no later than October 27, 2020. You may apply in-person up to the day before the election, November 2, 2020. Absentee ballots will be mailed after the application has been sent in. For voters returning their voted absentee ballot, it must be dropped off on or before November 3, 2020 and if sent by mail it must be postmarked by November 3, 2020.

### **2) VOTE DURING THE EARLY VOTING PERIOD OCT. 24th - NOV. 1st**
