Electrically Heated Buildings in the Capital Region

New York City recently prohibited fossil-fuel heating in most new building construction starting in 2024. The rest of state is likely to adopt similiar regulations in the coming weeks.

Right now, electrically-heated buildings is relatively uncommon in the Capital Region with several exceptions:

- Center Square Neighborhood, Albany
- Mansion Neighborhood, Albany
- · Pinewood Manor, Albany
- · Point of Woods, Albany
- Strawberry Ridge, Waterford
- · Knox Woods, Halfmoon
- Mill Creek, East Greenbush
