FAMED SENECA ORATOR AND CHIEF NAMED OTETIANI ("ALWAYS READY") AND LATER SA-GU-YE-WA-THA ("HE WHO KEEPS THEM AWAKE"). HE BECAME KNOWN AS RED JACKET AFTER HE WAS GIVEN A SCARLET COAT BY THE BRITISH AT THE END OF THE REVOLUTIONARY WAR. IN 1792 GEORGE WASHINGTON PRESENTED HIM WITH A LARGE SILVER MEDAL WHICH HE IS DEPICTED WEARING HERE.
