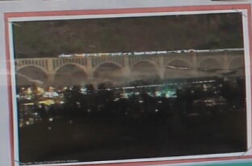


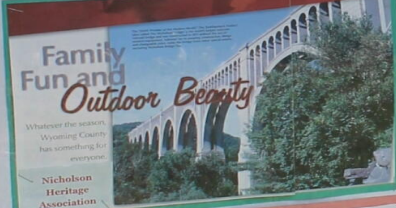
WE CALL IT THE NICHOLSON BRIDGE



THE BRIDGE
The Nicholson Bridge is a concrete arch bridge spanning the Susquehanna River. It was built in 1912-1913 and is one of the longest concrete arch bridges in the world. The bridge is named after the Nicholson family, who owned the land on which it was built.
