pennsylvania's scenic byways

On July 9, 2009, State Route 92 in Susquehanna County was designated as the Vardick Valley Way Scenic Byway. Other former segments of Nicholson Baroque, Nicholson Township, Tunkhannock Township, and the Wyoming County Commission, the history of the designation of Route 92 was established in Wyoming County by being the same length of the bridge to 9.2 miles. State Route 92 is the heart of Nicholson, Pa and needs to help other the Nicholson Bridge.

This designation is vital to the economic stability of Nicholson and the region. By providing location, the bridge highlights the natural and man-made beauty of the bridge structure to attract visitors. From the breathtaking views of Fall foliage to the inspiring grandeur of the Tunkhannock National Forest and the Starbuck's Market in Lenoirville, there is a place to see and do along the Route of the Famous Vardick.
