The round, wooden cases on the plat-  
form each contain a pair of millstones.

The miller controlled the coarseness of  
the meal by setting a wheel which raised  
or lowered the runner stone. The higher  
the runner, the coarser the meal.

A portion  
of the  
meal  
was  
removed  
by the  
runner on the  
flat  
side of the  
millstone.  
The millings  
produced a white  
original meal.

A screen  
was  
used to  
remove  
the  
bran  
from  
the  
meal.  
The  
bran  
was  
used  
for  
animal  
feed.
