

# OXBOW FALLS PARK

Oxbow Falls Park, a Madison County Park, covers of 125 acres of land. The park is open to the public year-round from dawn to dusk, and provides opportunities for fishing, picnicking, ball games, and other forms of outdoor recreation.

Three waterfalls are located at the park. Water drops approximately 100 feet from the upper falls. Clockwise Creek, the braided stream provides water to these falls, as well as to the lower Pond in the Town of Ferris.

The sharp change in elevation allows for excellent views and views across the Oxbow Lake Basin and on to Lake Ontario. Limestone outcroppings in the upper portion of the park are on the northernmost edge of the Helderberg Escarpment, which formed during the Devonian Period 400 to 350 million years ago.
