



# Debar Mountain Trail

The 3.7 mile Debar Mountain trail follows a snowmobile trail, then turns off on to a hiking trail that gently increases in elevation until about a mile from the top, near where the lean-to is located, then there is a steep incline for the last 8/10th of a mile with views from the partially-open summit to the south-west. There is a day use fee at Meecham Campground from mid-May until Labor Day Weekend.
