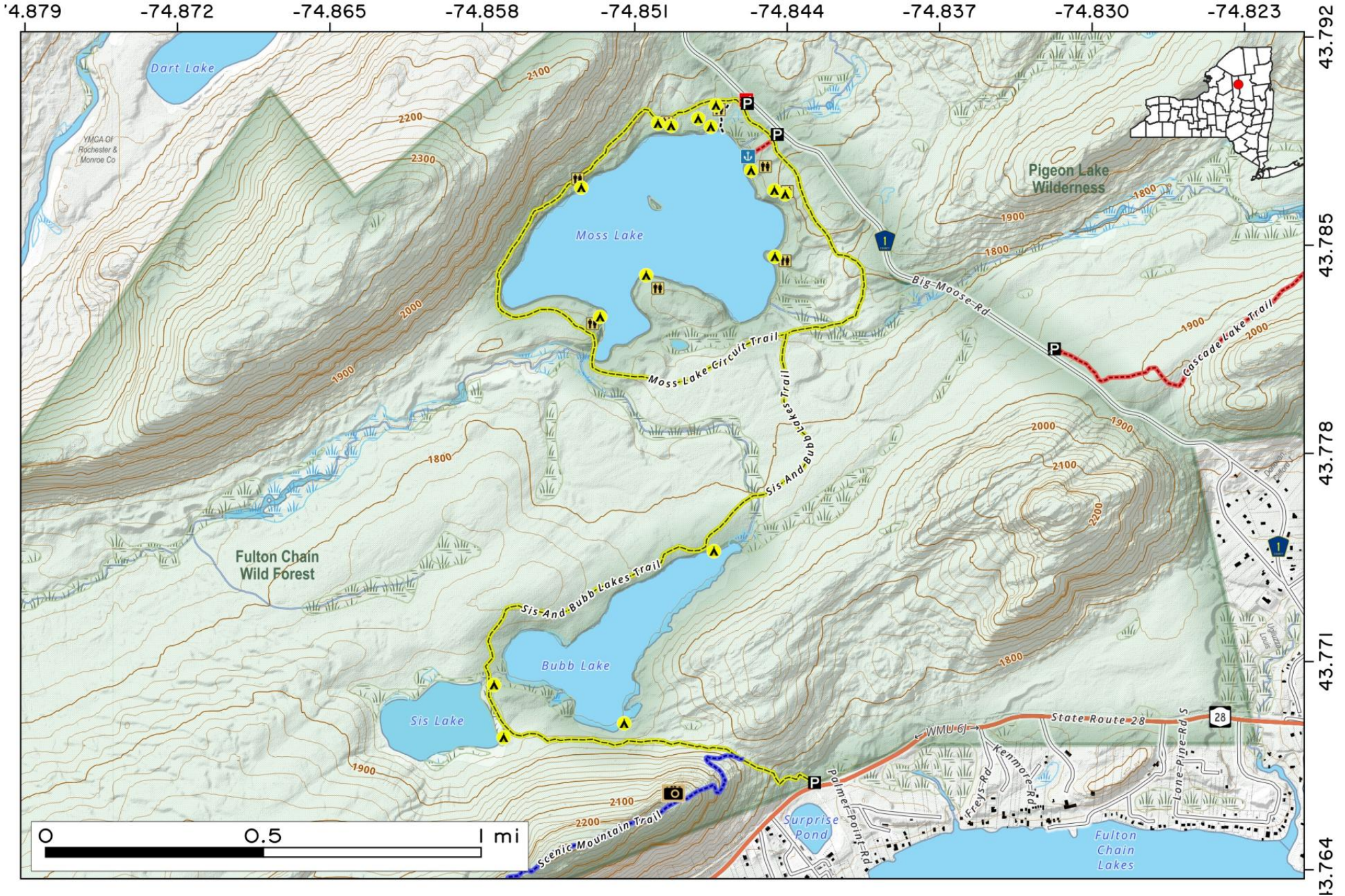


Bub And Sis Lakes From the NY 28 trailhead you climb up and over the shoulder of Vista Ridge — the Vista Trail will come on your left. Once you crest the ridge you will start a slow descent to the drainage between Sis and Bubb Lakes. A very nice footbridge spans the gap. You can continue to the north side of Bubb Lake for additional views; the trail ends at the Moss Lake Loop. Alternatively, you can come in from the Moss Lake Parking Area, and hike to Bubb and Sis Lake.

Bubb and Sis Lakes. The trail to the three lakes is a very pleasant walk in the woods suitable for families. It ascends about 200 feet and the walk to the nearest water is about 0.5 miles. The walk to the stream that flows between Sis and Bubb lakes (where both are visible) is about 0.9 miles. The total mileage for the whole loop including Moss Lake is 6.5 miles.
