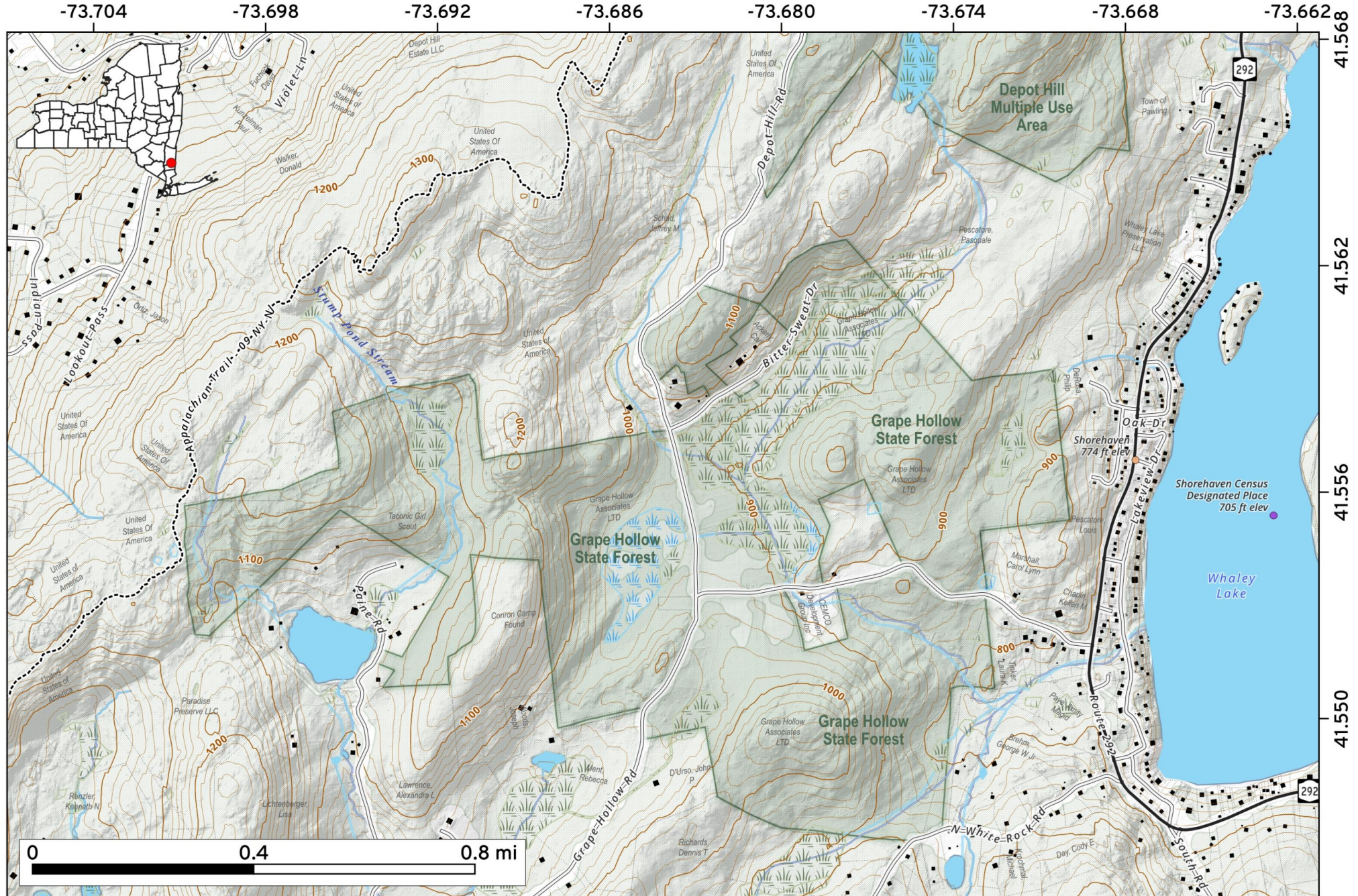


Grape Hollow State Forest is a 505-acre protected area in Beekman and Pawling, Dutchess County. Recently established in 2024, it directly adjoins the Appalachian Trail corridor, providing a critical viewshed buffer. This intact forest preserves wildlife migration corridors and offers rugged terrain for hunting, birdwatching, and off-trail exploration.

West Mountain State Forest is an 830-acre multi-use preserve in Dover, Beekman, and Union Vale. It features rugged terrain with mountains, wetlands, and seasonal waterfalls. Visitors enjoy approximately 4 miles of trails for hiking, horseback riding, and winter snowshoeing, alongside activities like hunting and backcountry camping.
