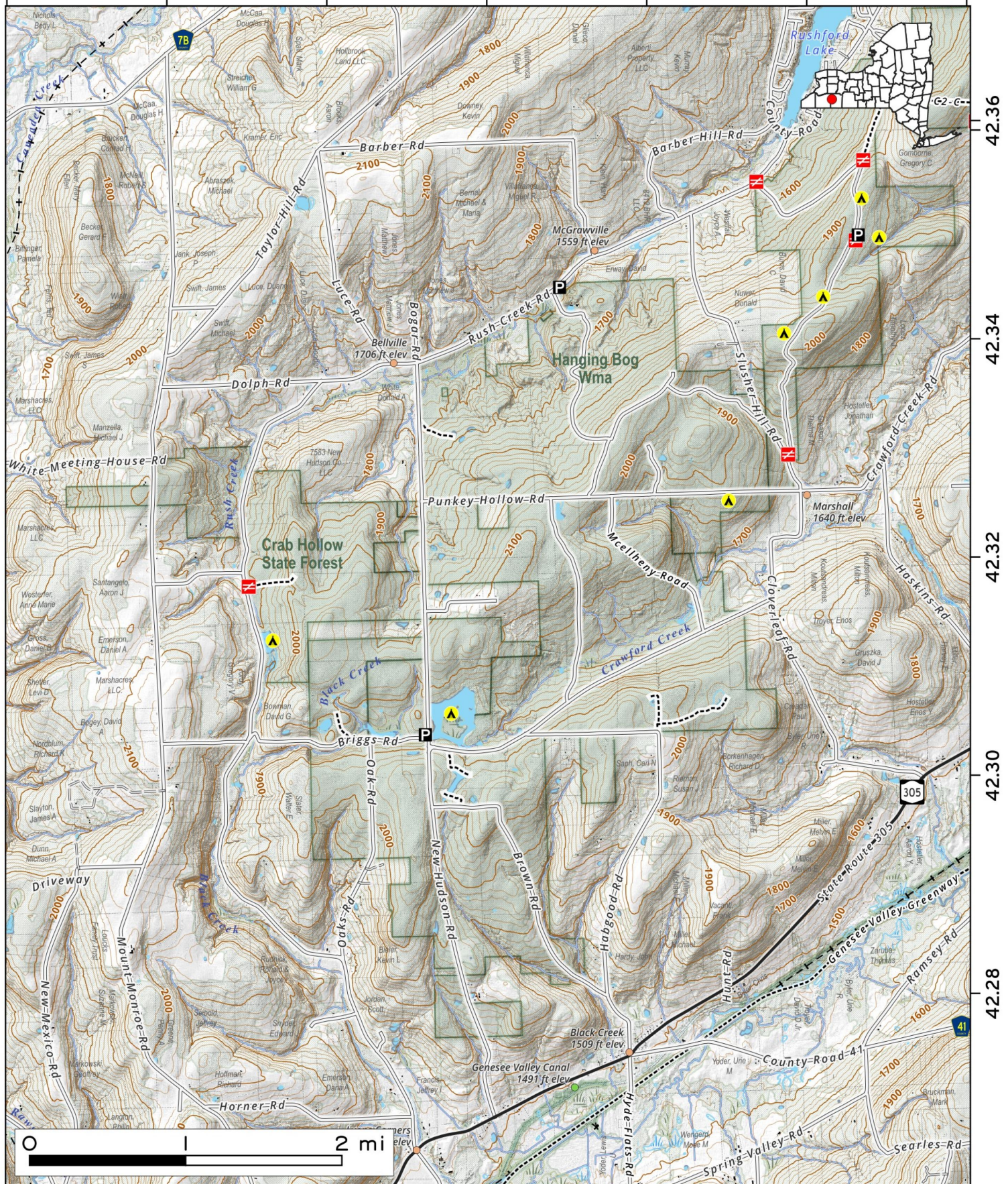


Hanging Bog Wildlife Management Area in Allegany County spans over 4,500 acres of rolling hills, dense forests, and marshes. 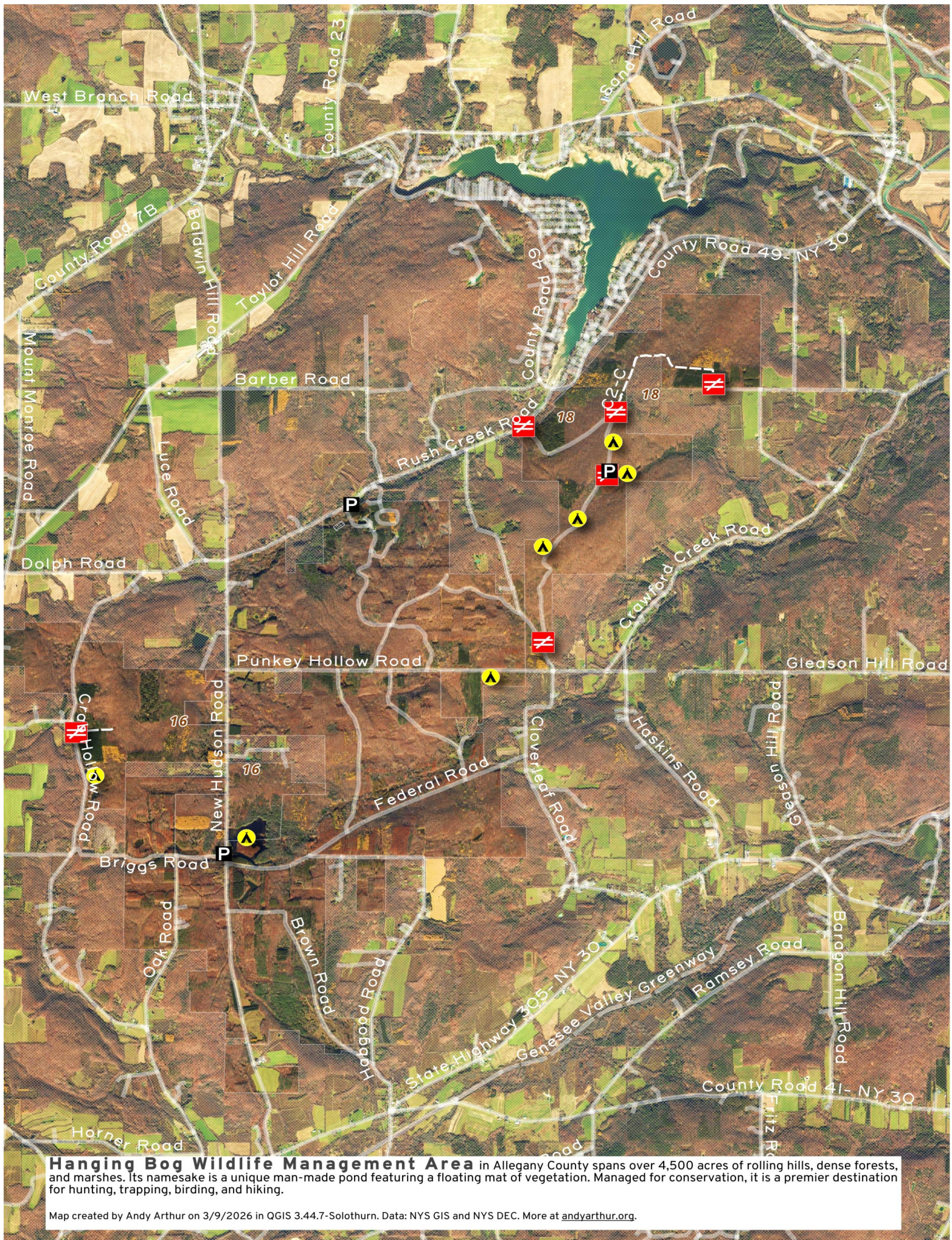
