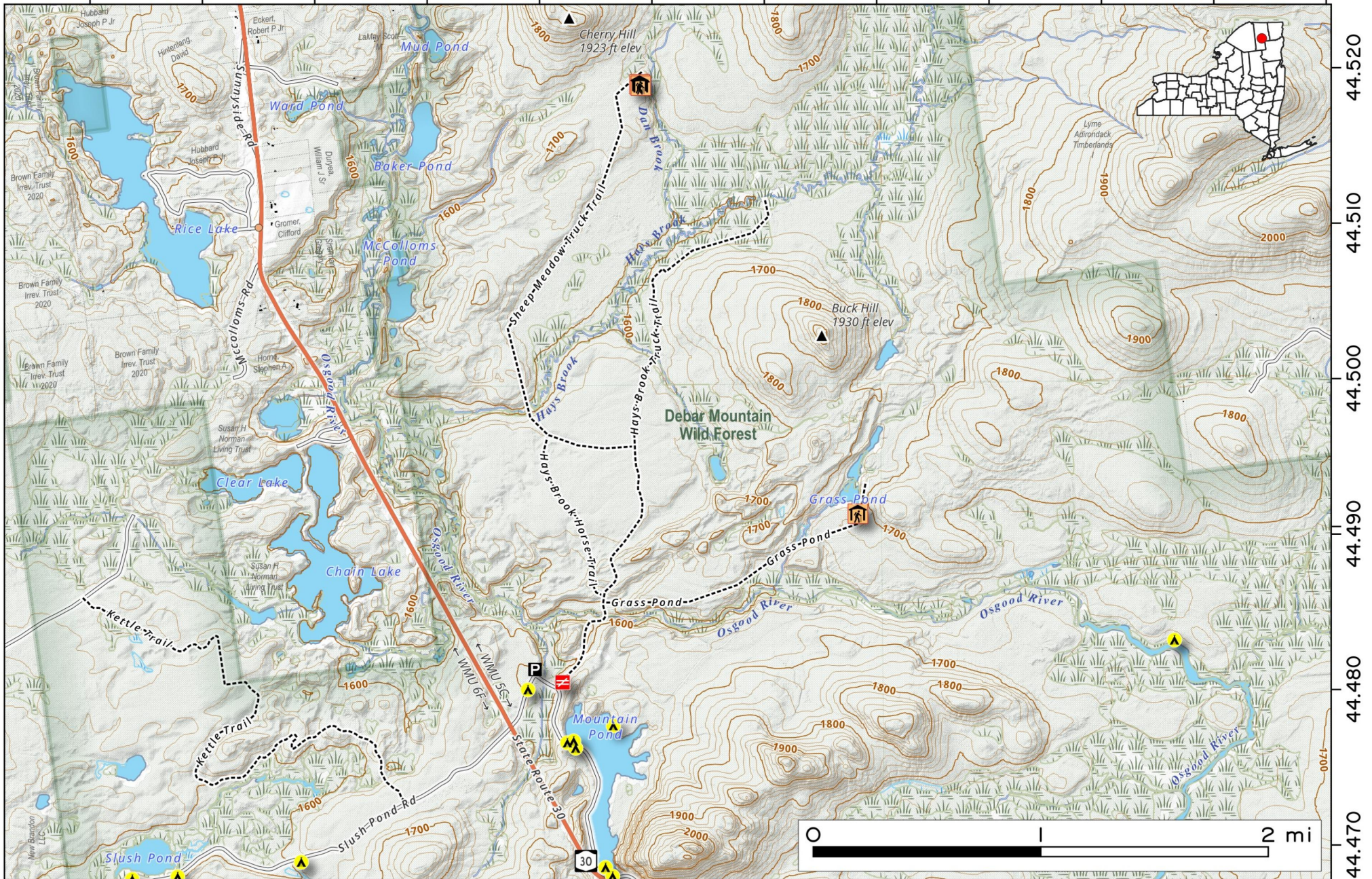


**Hays Brook Horse Trails.** North of Pauls Smiths on NY 30 there is Mountain Pond, and off Mountain Pond Road where it turns sharply west is the Hays Brook Horse trails that lead back to Grass Pond and Shepmeadow along old DEC-maintained fire protection roads carved into the forest preserve. Lightly used outside of hunting season, it can be accessed on horseback, mountain bike or foot but some sections may be swampy.

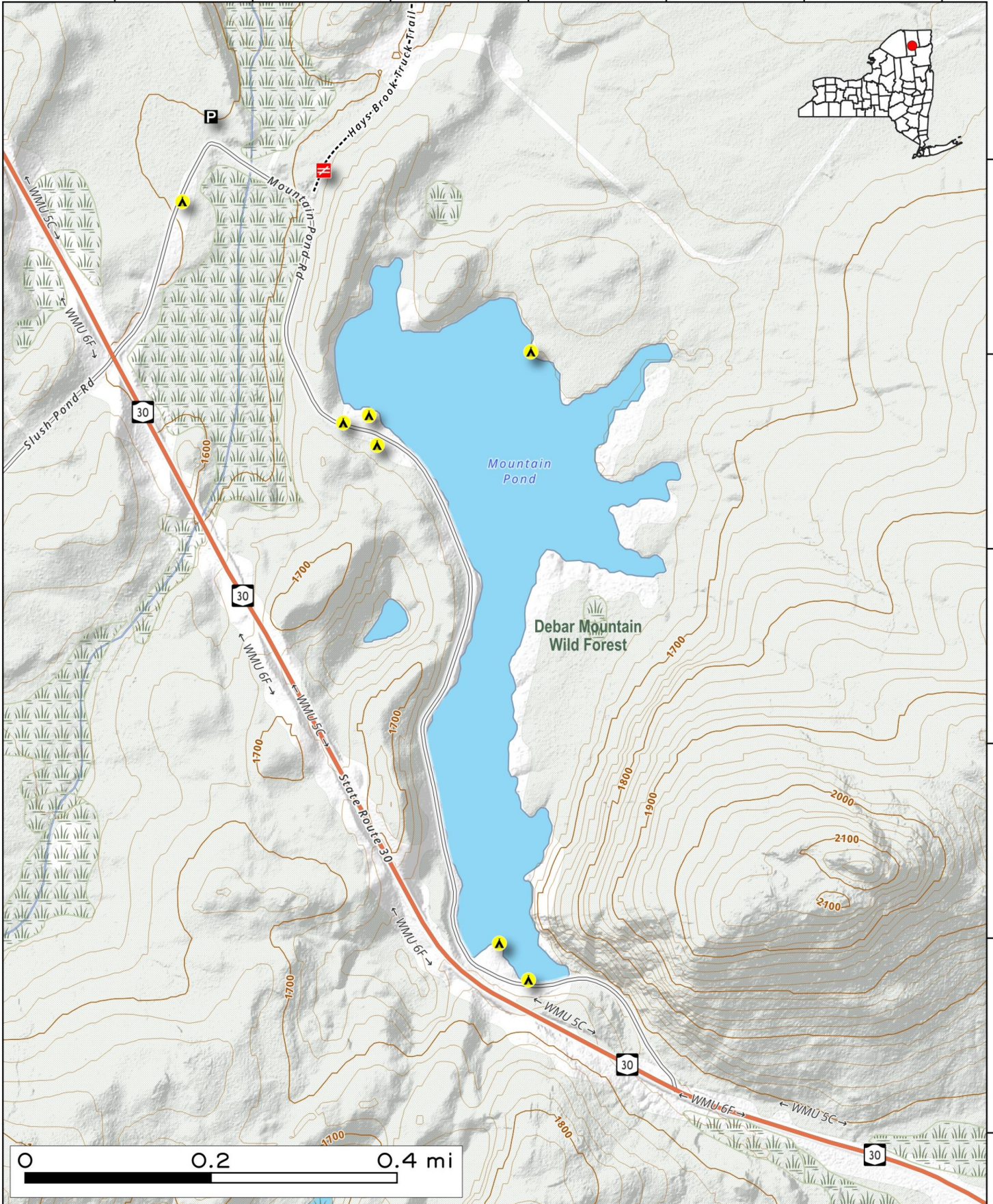
